



SUNNYSIDE PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP - 2011

The Sunnyside Property Owners Association (SPOA) strongly supports the continuing education of our youth and will award college scholarships to high school seniors that are residents of the Association's membership boundaries for their junior and senior years regardless of high school attended. A total of \$2000 will be awarded, via a minimum of two scholarships, at least one of which will be for \$1000. SPOA offers the 2010 Scholarships in memory of outstanding service to the community by past SPOA directors Walter & Doris Halemeier and to recognize Sunnyside students for their contribution to Sunnyside. The scholarships are available to entering freshmen that have demonstrated academic excellence and have performed a significant amount of community service or volunteer work.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- ❑ Be a graduating high school senior.
- ❑ Reside within the SPOA membership area boundaries (Kings Canyon, Temperance, Jensen and Peach Avenues) for their junior and senior years of high school.
- ❑ Be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university.
- ❑ Have a record of community service or volunteer work
- ❑ Have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average

How to Apply:

- ❑ Complete the scholarship application in full.
- ❑ Prepare a one-page, double-spaced typewritten essay discussing how your experiences in Sunnyside have impacted your life and why you should be considered for the Scholarship.
- ❑ Submit two (2) letters of recommendation from adults other than family members. The letters should be sealed from the letters' author and state why they feel you are qualified to receive the scholarship.
- ❑ Include an official cumulative high school transcript, including ACT/SAT scores.
- ❑ Do not fax your application. Only original applications will be accepted.
- ❑ Postmark your entry to SPOA by **April 5, 2011**.

Award Procedure:

Scholarships will be awarded in May 2011. All finalists must be available for a personal interview. Winners will be notified by mail in May 2011. Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable. Awards will be paid upon proof of registration at an institute of higher education. Applications must be complete to be considered.
